ANNUAL REPORT

IN 2016, BECAUSE OF YOUR SUPPORT,
CLUB MEMBERS:

- Spent 1,530 hours at the Clubs over the summer.
- Averaged 3.5 hours or more per day at the Club.
- The Clubs served more than 36,365 nutritious snacks last year.
- 90% said the Club was the best thing available for them in their community.
- Participated in 54,490 hours of Power Hour, a homework help and tutoring program that encourages members to be self-directed learners.
- Membership to attend the Club is only \$25 a year; but, the actual cost to the Club is \$754 annually;

85 PERCENT of kids said the Club taught them right from wrong.
